In the matter of Ada Greenwood Chapman
and Florence Chapman by Robert Chapman
their father and next friend.

Upon the application of the above named Infants Ada Greenwood Chapman and Florence Chapman by the said Robert Chapman their next friend and upon hearing the solicitors for the applicants and for John Thomas Coates and The Reverend Thomas Procter Ryby and upon reading Orders dated the 2^d August 1870 and the 13th March 1872 and an affidavit of Robert Chapman filed the 21st November 1871

It is ordered that fifty pounds per annum (free from Income Tax) be allowed in addition to the sum of One hundred and fifty pounds per annum allowed by the said Orders dated respectively the 2^d August 1870 and the 13th March 1872 making together Two hundred pounds per annum for the maintenance and education of each of the Infants Ada Greenwood Chapman and Florence Chapman the applicants for the time past as from the 1st day of September 1871 and for the time to come during their respective minorities or until further order. And it is ordered that such increased allowance of fifty pounds a year each be raised and paid by the said John Thomas Coates and Thomas Procter Ryby in the same manner as the respective allowances of One hundred and fifty pounds are directed to be raised and paid by the Orders of the 2^d August 1870 and the 13th March 1872 respectively.
