both of the said County of York Gentlemen to the said James Taylor
situate within and parcel of this Manor and held of the Lords thereof under the
apportioned yearly customary Rent of one Penny half penny and other dues duties
suits and services to have and to hold the said Hereditaments and premises
with the appurtenances for the Rent aforesaid unto the said James Taylor and
his heirs according to the custom of the said Manor and doing all other
services therefor due pursuant to a certain decree in the Court of Chancery of
the Lady Elizabeth late Queen of England in this behalf made and he goes to
the Lords Fifteen years rent and hath done fealty to the Lords and is thereupon
