In the Name of God Amen, The eighteenth
day of February one thousand eight hundred and forty six
I James Bennett of England in the parish of
Braithwaite in the West Riding of the County of York
Bullfinch, being very sick and weak of body, but of
perfect mind and memory do hereby make and declare this
my last Will and Testament that is to say I will my
funeral and testamentary expenses to be paid together with all
my just debts after what it is my Will and desire that my
Dear Wife should have and enjoy all my property of whatsoever
kind during the term of her natural life after what it is my
Will that it shall be divided equally amongst my children
the being share and share alike and in case any of them
shall die during the life of my Dear Wife it is the my Will
that their children if any shall receive their parents share equally
amongst them and in the case of any deceased daughter like
the late Wife of James Bennett Mother of Justice Rogers it
is my Will that her three children shall receive the share
which would have fallen to the Mother had she been
living equally amongst them share and share alike
but in case any of them should die the survivor or
survivors to receive the deceased child's children share
equally between them if more than one and in case they
should all die leaving no issue their share to be
equally divided amongst my remaining children or

their heirs, and should say Some W^{ch} the legs the
children of my deceased daughter Ann attain the age of
Twenty one year then I appoint my some in law
Joseph Hunter John Thomas Cooke and Richard Brown
Trustees for the said children until they do attain the
age of Twenty one year at which time a trustee of
them attaining their respective majorities then shall be become
due to them but I hereby do not and empower the said
Trustees to apply the interest of the said childrens stocks
to their advantage during their minority as may seem
best to them And I do hereby revoke, annul and
revoke every other power, Will or Will And I do hereby
appoint my Son the said Executive to this my last
Will and Testaments whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal the day and year above

and forty six the said Robert Dawson and Edmund
