## **ST. PETER'S CHURCH, STAINFORTH**

### **Settle, North Yorkshire**

Stainforth was originally part of the Ancient Parish of Giggleswick, with Settle, Langcliffe and Rathmell. Then, endowed by the initiative of local people, St. Peter's was built in 1842. The monuments in the churchyard date from this time. Family historians wishing to trace burials of Stainforth residents before this date should consult the registers of St. Alkelda's, Giggleswick.

### **MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS**

Each surname on the alphabetical list (page 3) is followed by reference letters plus numbers giving the location of monuments bearing the name, eg Smith A7, B14, C2.

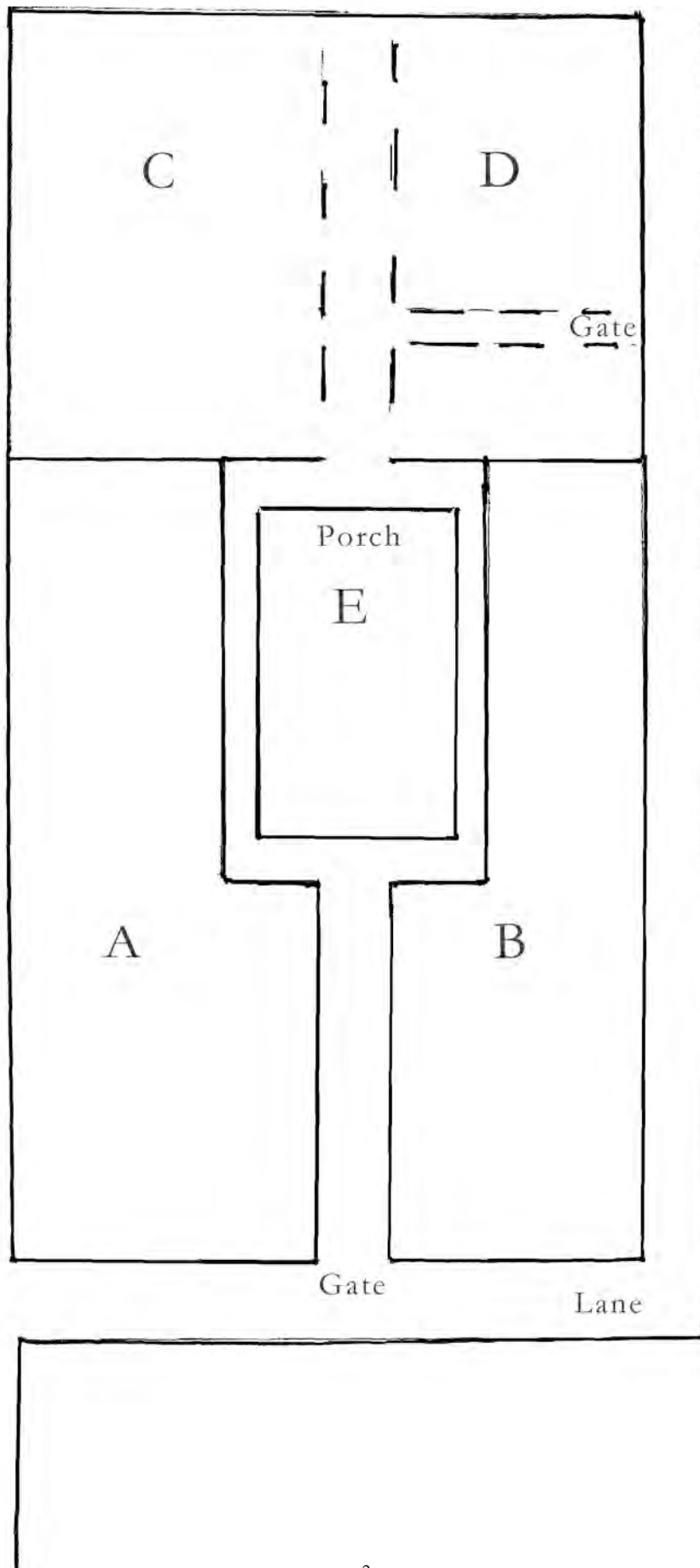
The letters A, B, C and D refer to the sections into which the churchyard has been divided. The inscriptions have been transcribed accordingly. Therefore the memorial to a member of the Smith family may be found in the list for Section A, grave number 7, and in Section B grave number 14 etc. Names on memorials inside the church are found in Section E, and on the War Memorial in Section F. Cremations may be found in Section C, as for example Ch.

For visitors to the church who are searching for particular graves, the sections are shown in the plan on page 2, and there is a plan of each section on pages 5, 9, 14, 19, 22 and 24.) The number of the grave is shown on the appropriate section plan.
