# North Craven Heritage Trust AGM Treasurer's Report

# Year Ending 31 August 2025

## Receipts

Subscriptions, admissions and donations declined further this year (£3,168/£4,431), as did Gift Aid (£573/£637). There was no Journal advertising. Book sales (£869/£799) and interest received (£2,218/£1,878) both increased.

## **Payments**

Administration costs declined by £2,136, which offset our reduction in general income. Printing costs also reduced (£1,641/£2,280) as no book reprints were required.

#### Grants

We made grants of £3,000 to The Folly to enable them to claim additional funding for their current major restoration project; and £196 for research transcription.

#### **Balances**

Our closing balance remains healthy (£61,272/£59,788) thanks to higher interest payments and lower costs. We will not see such favourable financial conditions in the future, as interest rates are going down, and administrative costs are negligible.

#### Outlook for 2025-26

Our new leaflet promoting grants is generating wider interest, geographically across North Craven and from new conservation areas.

## Independent Examiner of the Accounts

The accounts which follow have been examined by Ian Evans, a retired HM Inspector of Taxes. He has done this for the past three years for which we are very grateful. I hope that you will support Ian's re-appointment and express your thanks.

#### Note 1

The General Fund balances are held in a NatWest Current account and in a Skipton Building Society account. Legacy Fund balances are held in NatWest 35-day and 95-day accounts; and in Charity Bank fixed term deposits.

#### Note 2

Gift aid is claimed a year in arrears. The amounts shows refer to gift aid on subscriptions for the preceding year.

#### Note 3

The final payment from the estate of the late Joan Compton (£4,196) was received during the preceding year.

#### Note 4

There was no income from Journal advertising in this year because of a lack of volunteers to sell the space to local businesses.

#### Note 5

Interest from the Skipton Building Society account is credited to the General Fund. Interest from the NatWest notice accounts and from the Charity Bank term accounts is credited to the Legacy Fund.

#### Note 6

The drop in administration costs (2024/25 £56; 2024/24 £2192) reflects our lack of a paid Secretary this year. Trustees are searching for someone to help with the Secretarial function.

#### Note 7

Printing costs for the Grants promotion leaflet have been charged to the Legacy Fund.

#### Note 8

A grant of £3,000 was made to The Folly to enable additional funding; and £196 for research transcription.
